

THE ASSOCIATION OF SOUTHEASTERN STATE PARK DIRECTORS

BY-LAWS

1. The dues of the Association shall be set each year at the annual meeting.
2. The President of the Association may appoint any committees which seem necessary and advisable or which may be required by a vote of the members, provided that a majority of the membership of each committee be the active official in charge of a member state's park system.
3. In addition to the duties of President, Vice-President, and Secretary-Treasurer as outlined in the Constitution, each of these officers shall perform such other duties as are usual or incidental to their respective offices.
4. Invitations to host future annual meetings of the Association may be extended by any member state through any reasonable means, but preferably by advance written communication to either the President or Secretary-Treasurer. All such invitations, whether extended in writing or orally, received by the Executive Committee by the time it meets to decide on the time and place for the next annual meeting shall be given full and equal consideration.
5. These by-laws may be amended by a majority vote of those voting members present and voting at any meeting.
